## CHANCTONBURY YOUTH

Over the last five years, God has grown the youth ministry from very small beginnings to what we celebrate today. We are seeking someone who can take Chanctonbury Youth to the next level by:

Raising up young people to exercise 'Kingdom' leadership, teaching and equipping them to lead and impart God's Kingdom in their families, in youth and wider Church settings, and in their daily lives at school and college.

Establishing a visionary environment that trains and equips young people to rise up and peer-lead a new generation to Jesus.

Seeing, leading and implementing a growing and expansive youth ministry that aspires to realise the 2033 vision.

Continue to establish in the young people deep roots of personal relationship with God and discipleship through His Spirit and teaching them to feast on Biblical Scripture.



## FROM WHERE WE ARE... TO WHERE WE ARE GOING cont.

Chanctonbury Youth currently consists of around 40-50 young people aged 11-18, involving specific 'older youth' and 'younger youth' groups and sessions both on Sundays and midweek. Young people are valued by the whole Church and serve on various Church teams (worship, welcome, kids, etc.).

On the fourth Sunday evening of every month, we run the 'Spread the Fire' youth service for young people and have formed good relationships with other church youth groups who are also invited to attend. In recent years we have run a youth conference, and we would love to explore taking this to the next level and creating a mini Jesus-centered-festival for regional young people. We aspire for this to grow to become a key transformational festival for Chanctonbury Youth - and hundreds and thousands of young people across the South East.

The Youth team are regularly involved in the main secondary school in the area, invited in to share the Gospel as part of a wider chaplaincy team. Most recently we have had the privilege to share in all of the assemblies this year since Christmas, and we want the new Head of Youth to continue this chaplaincy role.



- This is a permanent role with a six-month probationary period. The post is based in the parish of Chanctonbury.
