- ~ An applicant must give clear evidence that they have had a true calling from the Lord Jesus Christ to full-time ministry that has been demonstrated by their commitment to full-time ministry over several years, which has included a willingness to sacrificially serve the Lord in difficult ministry environments where remuneration has not been a priority.
- ~ An applicant must have proved their commitment to the calling that they have had from the Lord Jesus Christ to full-time ministry by their previous commitment to obtaining at least three years of Christian Bible college or seminary training in theology and church ministries.
- ~ An applicant must confirm their wholehearted commitment to keeping and fulfilling MPCC's Mission and Vision and Statement of Faith.
- ~ An applicant must have a proven record of past church ministry with people from across a wide variety of multicultural backgrounds, including the multicultural backgrounds represented by the people who reside in East London.
- ~ An applicant must have a proven record of outreach to non-Christians from different religious backgrounds, including Hindu, Muslim, and Sikh.
- ~ An applicant must have a proven record of having been actively engaged with online Biblical preaching and teaching and discipleship ministries over the past couple of years.
- ~ An applicant must have current and permanent legal status to live and to work in the United Kingdom.

JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: SENIOR PASTOR

ACCOUNTABLE TO: The MPCC Leadership Team

PURPOSE: To be a committed member of the MPCC church family and to demonstrate a servant's heart by humbly serving the Lord Jesus Christ in the role of Senior Pastor through the Mission and Vision of Manor Park Christian Centre

MAIN TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, MPCC's Statement of Faith and to be actively involved in whatever tasks and responsibilities that are necessary for the ongoing fulfilment of MPCC's Mission and Vision
- 2. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, MPCC's primary ministry that is outworked through MPCC's Cell Groups and Salt & Light Groups and to be actively involved in maintaining the schedule, Bible studies, and supplies of the Cell Groups and the training and envisioning of those who have responsibilities in connection with this ministry
- 3. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, all the various ministries of MPCC, including the discipleship ministry, the prayer ministry, the children's ministry, the youth ministry, the catering ministry, the compassionate ministry, the music ministry, and any other ministries of MPCC
- 4. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, and to be actively involved in the edification and equipping of believers and followers of Jesus Christ through the weekly online and in person Sunday services with regular and systematic Biblical preaching and teaching of God's Word that is wholly in line with MPCC's Statement of Faith and the Biblical doctrines and traditions of Manor Park Christian Centre
- 5. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, and to be actively involved in the evangelisation of non-believers, including the loving outreach to non-Christians from a wide variety of multicultural backgrounds and different religious backgrounds
- 6. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, and to be actively involved in the development, updating, and maintenance of MPCC's website and social media platforms
- 7. To oversee, along with MPCC's Leadership Team, the hiring of MPCC's church building facilities and to ensure that they, along with the manses, are properly insured, cared for, and maintained and that all the required certifications and inspections are carried out in a timely manner
- 8. To be responsible for ministry tasks such as overseeing weddings, funerals, and monthly Sunday communion services and to be actively involved in other ministries such as hospital visitations, special church family or cell group or individual functions and events, and to provide references for members of the MPCC church family
- To become a member of the MPCC Leadership Team with the responsibility of conducting its regular meetings and prayer times and to be committed to adhering to the Memorandum and Articles of Association of Manor Park Christian Centre

- The ministry of God the Holy Spirit, who leads us to repentance, unites us with Christ through new birth, empowers our discipleship and enables our witness.
- 10. The Church, the body of Christ both local and universal, the priesthood of all believers—given life by the Spirit and endowed with the Spirit's gifts to worship God and proclaim the gospel, promoting justice and love.
- 11. The personal and visible return of Jesus Christ to fulfil the purposes of God, who will raise all people to judgement, bring eternal life to the redeemed and eternal condemnation to the lost, and establish a new heaven and new earth.
