



### JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: Community, Children & Youth Lead

Responsible to: The Leadership Team, you will be part of the Ministry Team

Note: This role could form part of a job share or be fulfilled as 2 part time roles.

#### Introduction:

We are a large community of Christians from the local area of Bookham, Effingham, Fetcham, Leatherhead and beyond. Our church family caters for all ages and stages of life.

We have an exciting new role to work within our local community. The role will have a twofold focus, to oversee our current children and youth work programme and to develop stronger connections between our existing community projects and our worshipping community.

For many years we have been known for our thriving children's work. Following Covid, we have significantly fewer children and families regularly attending our Sunday worship services. We continue to have a dynamic and dedicated team of volunteers and a desire to serve this age group.

The person coming into this role will be expected to prioritise our objective of attracting and welcoming more children and families into the life of our church.

The good news is that we are seeing many people connecting in different ways with the church throughout the week, e.g. through the Children's Centre, Friday Youth, Community Fridge, Community Space, our work with older adults and more. Our desire is to develop meaningful relationships with those individuals coming through our doors, offering pastoral support, a clear path into the worship life of our church and into a relationship with Christ.

Adopting a chaplaincy approach, as Community, Children & Youth Lead you will work to foster relationships that build bridges with our local community and offer opportunities for them to explore faith. You will also play an important role in leading our existing children's and youth teams as they seek to engage and disciple young people in our church and beyond.

This new role presents an opportunity for a creative and motivated individual to bring their gifts to Bookham Baptist Church, and to shape our community engagement, children's and youth work in new and exciting ways to reflect the times we are in.

## Main responsibilities:

- Lead on strategy and vision for community, children's and youth work.
- Lead, support and build our teams of children's and youth work volunteers.
- Work alongside the Operations and volunteer teams to oversee the smooth delivery of regular and seasonal youth and children's activities and events.
- Adopt a chaplaincy approach to engage with those who come into our building through our community activities, providing pastoral care and opportunities to explore faith.
- Maintain and build strong connections with the local community, linking to current projects within Bookham Baptist Church
- Build connections with our worshipping community. Develop bridge building activities e.g. Summer Activities programme, and work with volunteer teams to deliver courses/resources which offer an opportunity for seekers to explore the Christian faith.
- Engage in outreach in the wider community
- Oversee the outworking of community, children's and youth work at Bookham Baptist Church and ensure consistent and effective discipling and pastoral care.
- To be a part of the Sunday activities of the church

### 1. Salary
