PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

We are seeking an Assistant Pastor (Youth & Young Adults) to join our Senior Leadership Team. This is an exciting opportunity to help oversee the life and ministry of TFW Church. Part of the Assistant Pastor's responsibility will be the

spiritual health and vitality of our Youth and Young Adult ministries, as well as enjoying a wider leadership role in the life of the church, preaching and developing vision.

Our current staff team consists of the Lead Pastor, Care & Connections Pastor, Operations Manager, and CAP Debt Coach.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Youth and Young Adults (approx. 50%)

- Overseeing our team of dedicated volunteers to provide an excellent culture of youth (11-17) and young adult (18-30) ministry.
- Fostering a culture which recognises, develops, and releases the gifts of young people in the church.
- Creating an intentional discipleship culture among the youth and young adults.

Ministry Team (approx. 50%)

- Be part of the preaching/teaching team. This will develop in line with experience and under the guidance of the Lead Pastor.
- Connect with the wider congregation through conversation, care, and a loving attitude.
- Help to oversee and encourage the volunteers of the church.
- Cultivating connections with other ministries, churches, and organisations in our area.
- Assist in the planning and delivery of special events.
- Participate in staff meetings, SLT meetings, and planning sessions.
- Contribute to the ongoing strategy and vision of the church.
